#### PREPARATIONOF THE TRAINING

## 1) The CMDL

Driven by a genuine desire to transmit and defend jazz and improvised music, musicians Didier Lockwood, Benoit Sourisse and André Charlier created the CMDL in 2000. As an institution of higher education, the Centre des Musiques Didier Lockwood is intended to support young musicians towards professional life and to enable teachersalready in practice to develop their careers. The school is now authorised to provide initial or continuing vocational training leading to a diploma, thanks in particular to the partnership established with one of theuniversities of Evry/Paris Saclay.

## 2) Admission Requirements

- Candidates who do not meet this condition can apply for an exemption when registering online. He will have to detail his situation in a few words.
- Be 26 years of age or older (as of December 31 of the year of the start of the school year)
- Not have interrupted their studies for more than 2 years
- JAZZ (DNOP jazz) or a Diploma of Musical Studies
  - apply for an exemption when registering online. He will have to detail his situation in a few
- Be a professional musician: you must have at least 2 years of seniority in the profession and 48 fees in the last two years prior to applying for funding for the training from the competent bodies.
- Have interrupted their studies for more than 2 years.

## 3) Objectives of the training

The Master's degree in Musicology "Musical Teaching and Practices" at the CMDL allows:

- To provide trainees with a working method that allows them to master instrumental technique and acquire a real artistic dimension,
- To develop their individual creativity and their personal project,
- To acquire the culture of jazz and the knowledge of the styles that come from it by consolidating rhythmic, harmonicand melodic concepts (improvisation, interpretation),
- To make traineesautonomous and thus to be able to adapt to all professional situations.

The training leads to two diplomas:

► The Master's Degree in Musicology and Engineering of Contemporary Music

The Master's trainee follows his training at the CMDL and at the University of Evry/Paris Saclay to obtain his Master's degree in Musicology. In this way, he acquired a higher academic level of knowledge and skills in jazz and improvised music. It reinforces their general culture and mastery of information and communication technologies.

#### ► The CMDL Diploma

The Centre des Musiques Didier Lockwood awards the CMDL diploma to studentswho have obtained an overall mark of more than 70% in the exams. Hecertifies a high level of masteryin jazz and improvised music.

## 4) Professional integration and further studies

The Master training allows you to:

- preparation for the National Education recruitment exams at all levels, but with priority given to the CAPES and the agrégation; stakeholders in different structures (CFMI, etc.); Introduction to academic musicological research
- access to careers in music and artistic communication (journalism, criticism, etc.) as well as the professions of libraries and specialized media libraries
- The beginning of the life of a professional musician.

## **5)** Organization of studies

In initial training  The course takes place over two academic years (from September to June), each divided into two semesters. The Master's student is enrolled in three institutions:  • The CMDL, where he received almost all of his teachings • The University of Evry/Paris Saclay, where he takes classes one day a week (Wednesdays), to obtain his Master's degree in musicology • Université Paris-Saclay for administrative registration	The Master's course in continuing education is accessible through the validation of previous learning (see page 6). Thus, the candidate can be accepted directly into the 2nd year of the Master's degree. Its training takes place over one or two academic years (from September to June), each divided into two semesters. #### 6) Course content

The overall content of the training is evenly distributed between practical, theoretical, cultural and methodological teaching.

- COURSES at the University of Evry/Paris Saclay: English and two musicology courses defined each year.
- → TEACHINGS at the CMDL

Beyond the theoretical and technical teaching of music, the pedagogies put in place strive to reveal the musical identity and the creative potential of each musician. Thus, between creative times, album releases, stages and tours, the pedagogical team invests and accompanies the trainees in their learning. In addition, nearly 80 musicians-speakers share the fruits of their experiences with new generations of musicians each year.

The training modelin Annex 2 details the training programme for each semester, the number of hours and the methods of checking knowledge.

## 7) Selection process

Step 1: The online registration form

The candidate completes the online application form and provides all the requested documents before the registration deadline. The list of documents to be gathered before online registration, as well as the dates and information not to be forgotten, can be found in the appendix1.

After the closing of applications and the derogation committee, the list of candidates admitted to sit for the admission tests shall be made public.

Candidates who require special accommodations in order to take the admission tests must send their request as soon as possible to the CMDL Tuition Service. In consultation with the candidate, the CMDL will put in place the appropriate measures (third time, adapted supports, etc.).

► Step 2: Admission tests

The successful candidate is invited to take the admission test on the day and at the time that will be posted on the website, at least 15 days before the test. The candidate must take the test 15 minutes before the time of the convocation. Any absence from the admission test is eliminatory.

The admission tests consist of a written test and a practical test.

The exams will take place in person unless the health conditions do not allow it. Inthis case, they will take place remotely (via avideoconferencing platform).

#### Written test

- Musicology test at university (for those without a bachelor's degree in musicology)
- Harmony and writing test
- Dictation (melodic line and chords). The tuning fork is recommended during this event.
- Recognition of musical excerpts

These tests will be used to evaluate the candidates, they are not eliminatory.

## Practical proof

- Interpretation of an instrumental program composed of:
  - 1 free piece chosen by the jury from among the 2 works proposed by the candidate. These works can be pieces from the repertoire, original compositions or arrangements of pieces from the repertoire. The complete scores of the 2 works for the rhythm section (double bass, drums and piano and a score for the jury) are pieces to be attached to the application file. They should be no longer than 2 pages (each) and should be written with music software.
  - 1 piece chosen by the jury from the list of 10 compulsory pieces.
    - This list is available on our website cmdl.eu
    - The candidate must knowall the songs. Hewill be askedto perform one of them without a score. The candidate will be accompanied exclusively by the CMDL's escorts. The chaperones will not provide any rehearsals with the candidate. The total duration of the program should not exceed 12 minutes, with the jury reserving the right to interrupt the candidate at any time.
- An interview with the jury, including about the study project

<u>Special case</u>: foreign or French candidates living abroad who are unable to take the entrance exam due to distance may apply to the administration for an exemption in order to take the admission tests remotely. The CMDL administration reserves the right to accept or refuse this request. In case of acceptance, an online appointment for an audition and an interview will be arranged between the juries and the candidate, on a date defined by the institution.

The number of diploma courses (DNSPM, Bachelor's, Master's and Professional Training) is limited to 9 trainees per instrument.

## 9) How to register

The candidate admitted to the Master's program will have to register in the 2 partner institutions:

► At the CMDL

Registration is final after receipt of the training contract and the signed study payment as well as the payment of the deposit before the date indicated on the admission email or letter.

► At the University of Evry/ Paris Saclay

Following the entrance examination, the CMDL forwards the list of selected candidates to the University of Evry/Paris Saclay. Candidates in continuing education must then contact the University's Continuing Education Service (VAE) to proceed with their registration. ## 10) Validation of prior learning

For the admission of a trainee in continuing education to the Master's course, we will speak of "validation of professional and personal experience". After admission, the trainee submits an application for a VAPP. This request will be examined by a committee composed of the head of the university and the director of the CMDL or her representative, which proposes, as the case may be:

- validation.
- a role-playing by the teacher,
- validation by examination (exemption type).

Depending on the case, the validation results in:

- the full validation of a discipline and the allocation of the corresponding ECTS points,
- exemption from all or part of the courses in one or more disciplines but not from the final examination of the subject(s),
- ► the allocation of part of the ECTS points in one or more disciplines.

These provisions may lead to a reduction in the duration of training.

#### **Funding for training**
